The fall trial has been National Red Setter Field in the various states Trial Club, Inc. opportunity to compete and see our Red Dogs in competition. Our spring trial has been held in Ohio for JTF: jlp at six years and is called the Mid-west National Red Setter Field Trial Championship.
