We have some National Parks set up just now in Ireland which incorporate some of our traditional Trial grounds. The State organisation responsible for these National Parks is refusing all efforts to have trials this year on this ground on the basis that it is an international ideal that no hunting is allowed on National Parks - I believe this is not the case in America - could you do me a great favour
