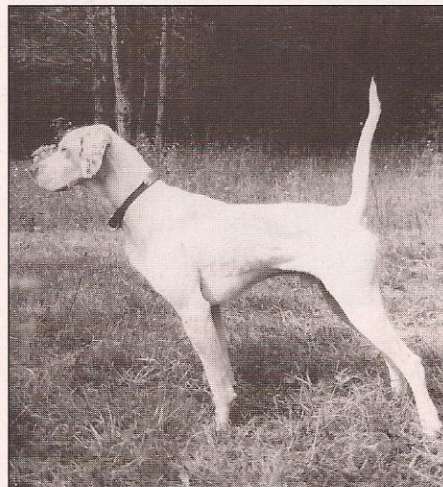

Tim McClurg made a clean sweep of the Open Shooting Dog with Mac's



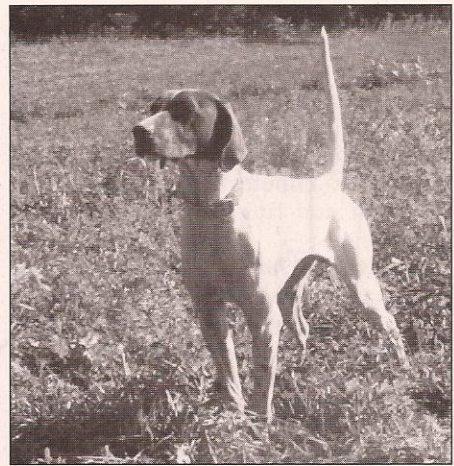
MAC'S SILVER DOLLAR
